
WFP supported DRR activities in


57 countries in all WFP regions.





Main objectives of the 2011 DRR Policy

- 1. Provide WFP with clear policy guidance anchored in our mandate and mission and built on our comparative advantages.
- 2. Clarify the link between disasters, risk management, and food security
- 3. Provide principles for WFP activities in DRR, strengthen partnerships, and ensure support to government-led processes.



Priorities for DRR Policy Implementation

- 1. Emergency preparedness and response
- 2. Capacity development in and policy support to food security-related DRR
- 3. Analytical capacity to link food security, disaster risk, climate change, and conflict
- 4. Programme quality enhancement
- 5. Partnerships
- 6. Monitoring and evaluation and cost effectiveness
