

## **Critical Risks**

#### Contextual Risks:

Weather related risks
 (droughts, floods)
Insecurity and political disturbances (BKF and CIV, potentially in large number of countries going through elections in 2011/2012
High Food Prices affecting

mainly the coastal countries

#### **Programmatic Risks:**

 -Limited number and/or capacity of partners to implement WFP activities in several countries
- Not enough food available to address identified needs

#### **Institutional Risks:**

 Inability to mobilize critical staff for responses to crisis
Inadequate resources to fulfill WFP mandate

# **Summary Risk Analysis**

### **Key risks**

- Weather related risks
- Insecurity and political instability (BKF and CIV, potentially in large number of countries going through elections in 2011/2012), Presence of AQMI in the Sahel
- High food prices affecting mainly the coastal countries
- Limited number and/or capacity of partners to implement WFP activities in some countries
- Inability to mobilize critical staff for responses to crisis

## **Mitigation measures**

- Strengthening emergency preparedness and response/early warning capacity, supporting contingency planning processes and regional disaster risk reduction mechanisms
- Use of third parties for monitoring
- Strengthening of market/price monitoring systems
- Use of government structures
- Enhancement of existing partners capacity
- Establishment of regional rosters of staff
