CD will be able to answer the following at any time:

Who and how many need and actually receive food assistance? (Beneficiary Numbers by Category, Type, Gender, and Age Group)

Where are they?

To the achievement of which outcomes and strategic objectives food assistance should contribute?

How (i.e. GFD, FFW, etc.) and for how long food assistance should be provided and how was actually provided ?(Food Deliveries by Cooperating Partners)

Which and how much commodities should be distributed and which ones/how much were actually distributed? (Food Distributions by Activity and Beneficiary Characteristics)

Which results should be and have actually been achieved through food and non-food distribution activities?

Which activity and/or costs should I prioritize based on projected income?

How far will my current and project income take me?
