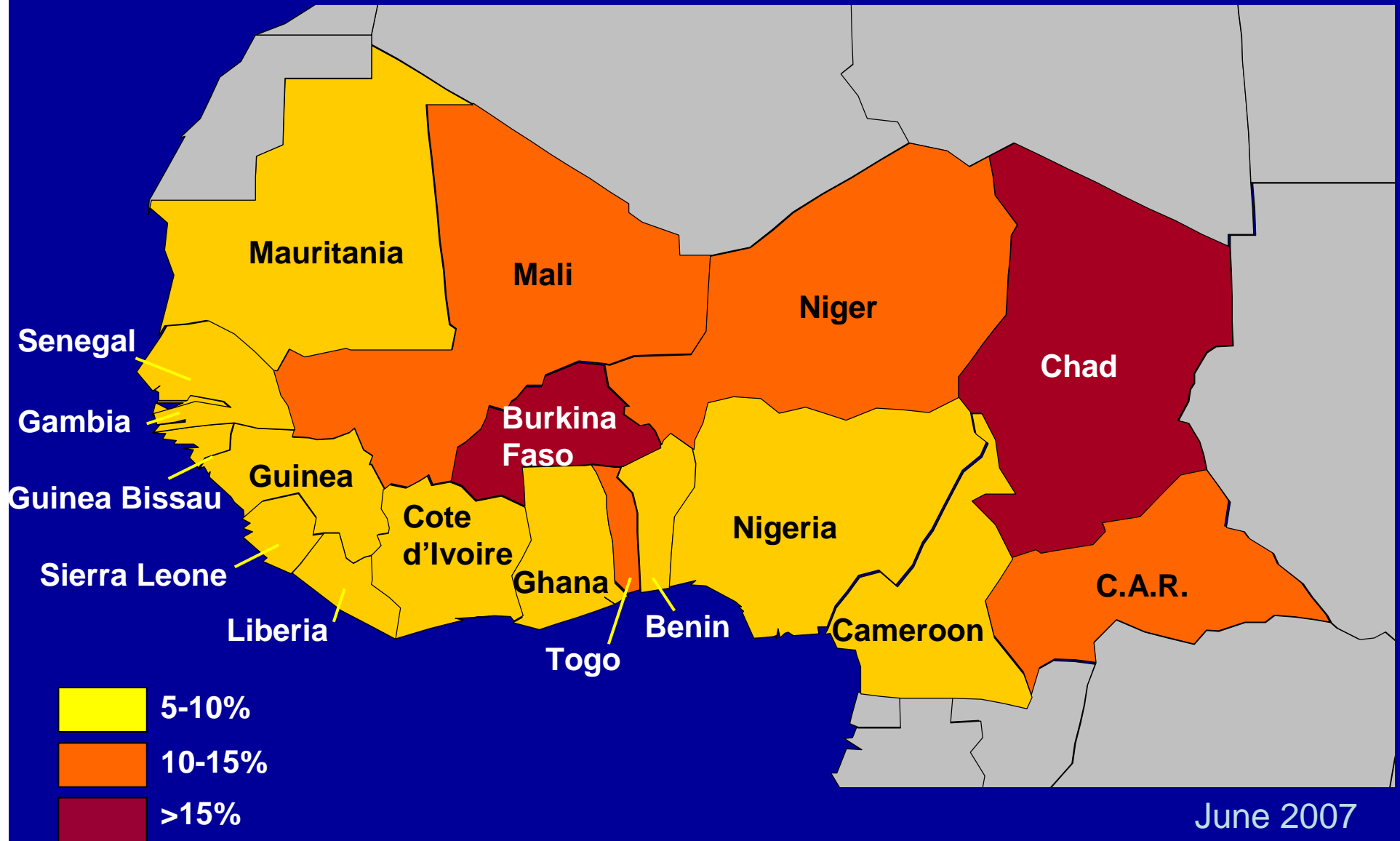

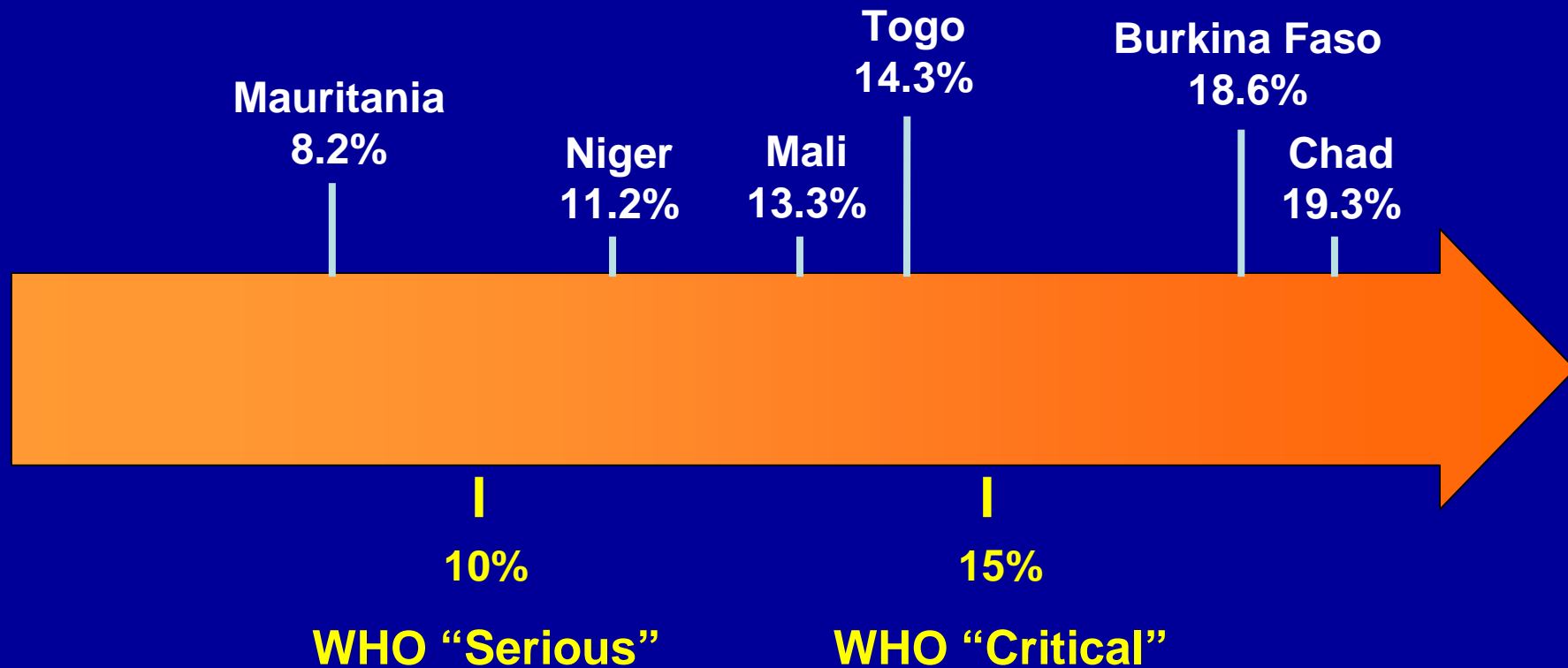

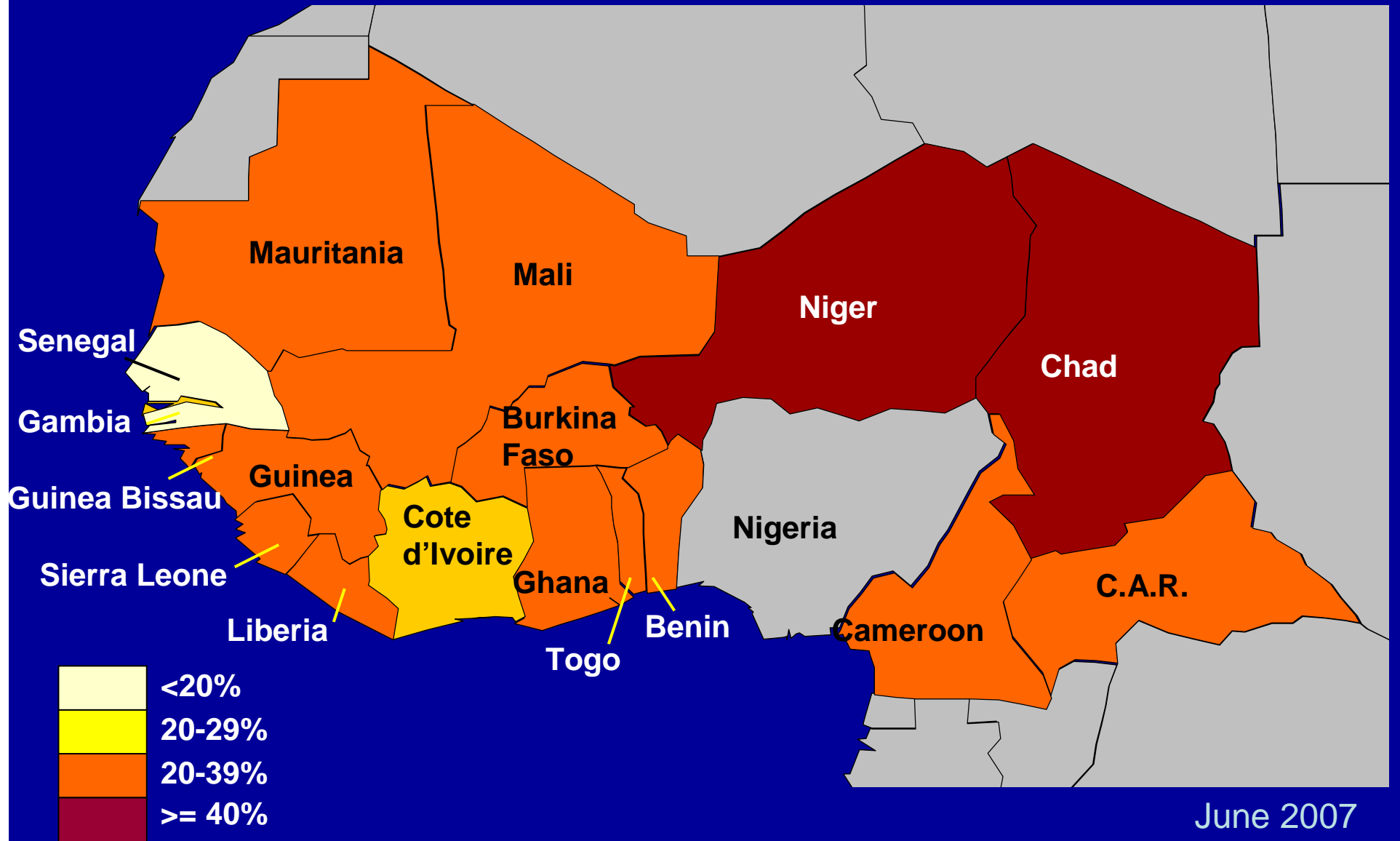
Acute Malnutrition in Children Under 5: Prevalence



Acute Malnutrition in the Sahel: the highest Rates in the World

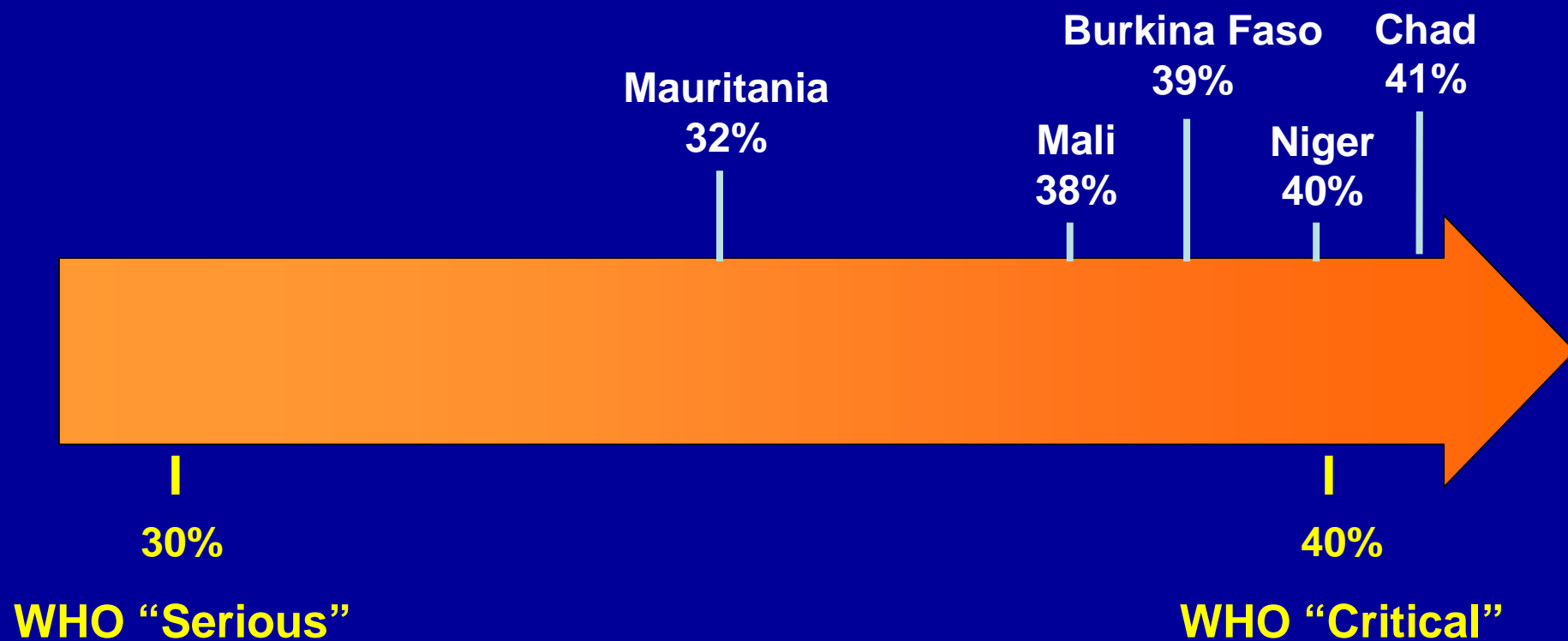


Chronic Malnutrition in Children Under 5: Prevalence

Build consensus around the severity of the malnutrition problem and need for urgent action

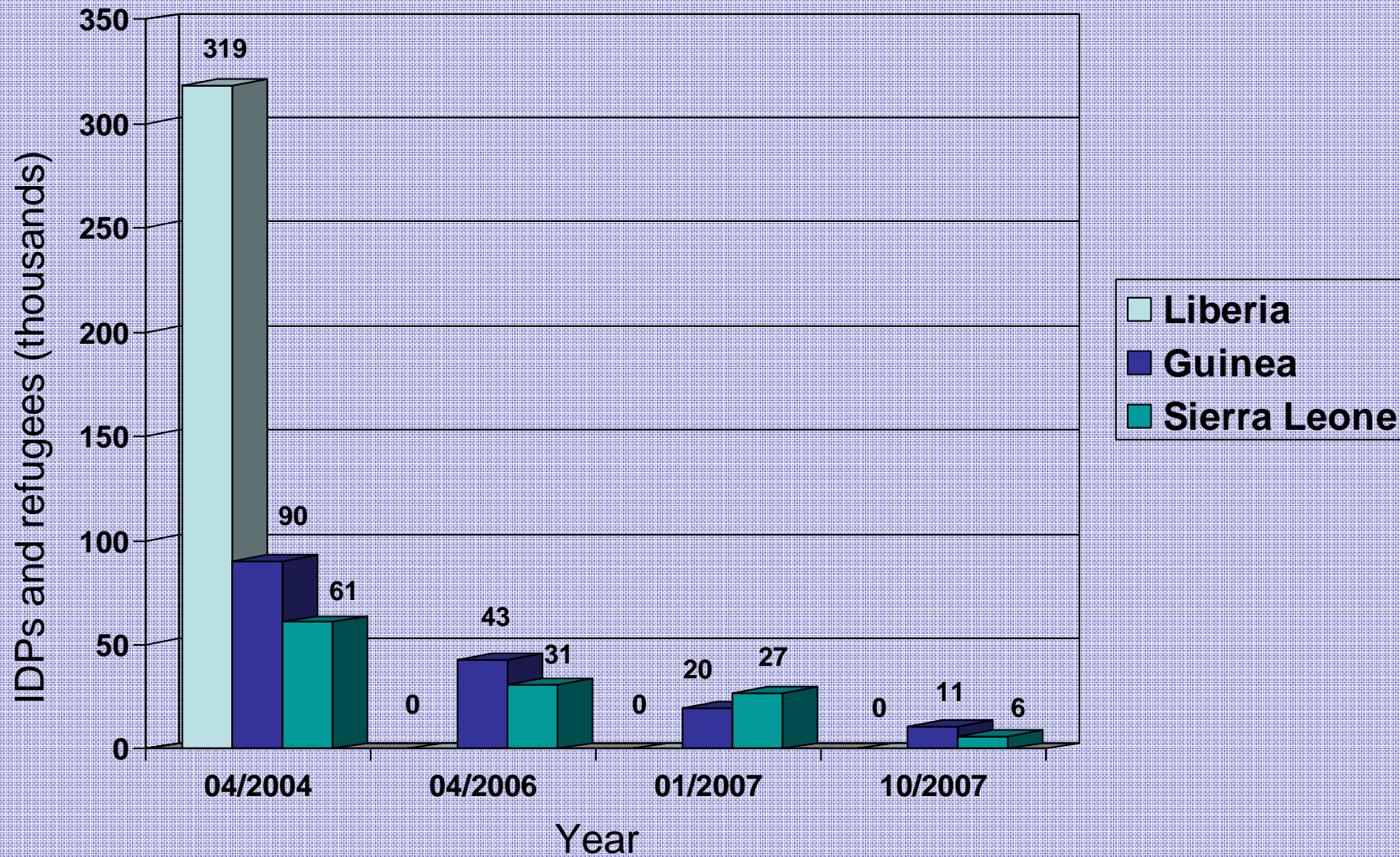
Joint Response

Strategic response based on key priority interventions: evidence based and rapidly scalable

Prioritization

Drive governments and international financial partners to prioritize nutrition in overall poverty-reduction and development frameworks

Consensus building

Regional level meeting to build consensus between UNHCR and WFP on strategy for repatriation

Joint Action Plan

A detailed action plan established for both agencies with timelines, and a coordinated communication strategy to ensure that refugee population is informed

Careful and thorough follow up on action plan, plus a follow up regional level review.
