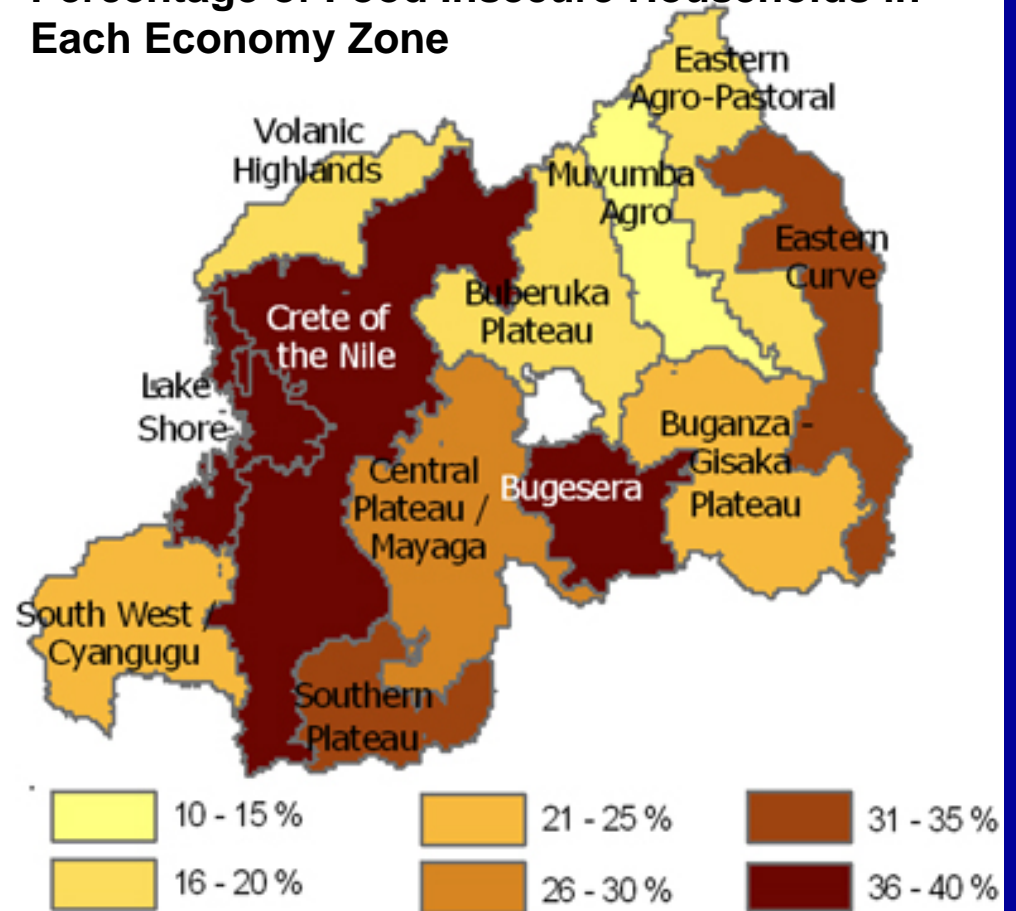
- Number of beneficiaries: 290,000

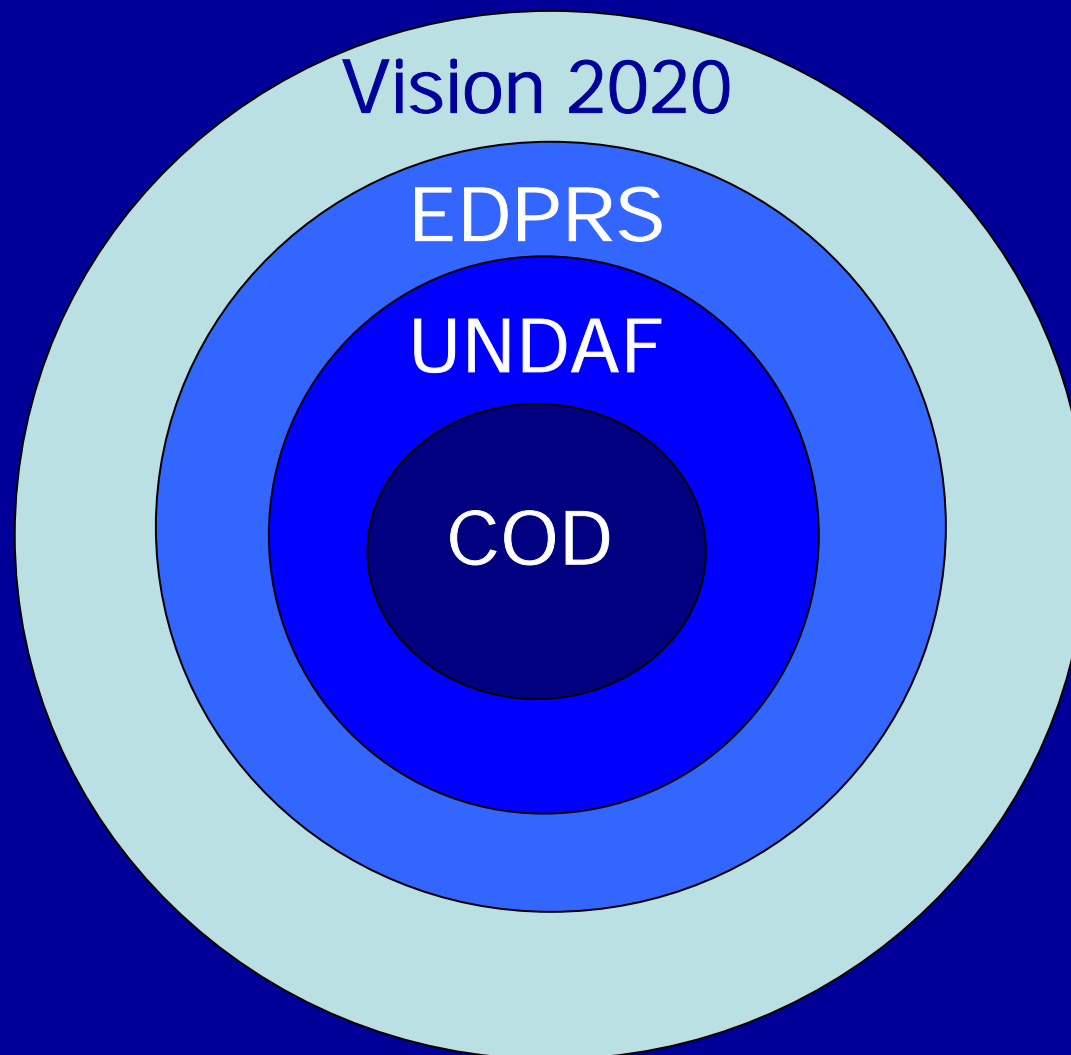
# Background Information

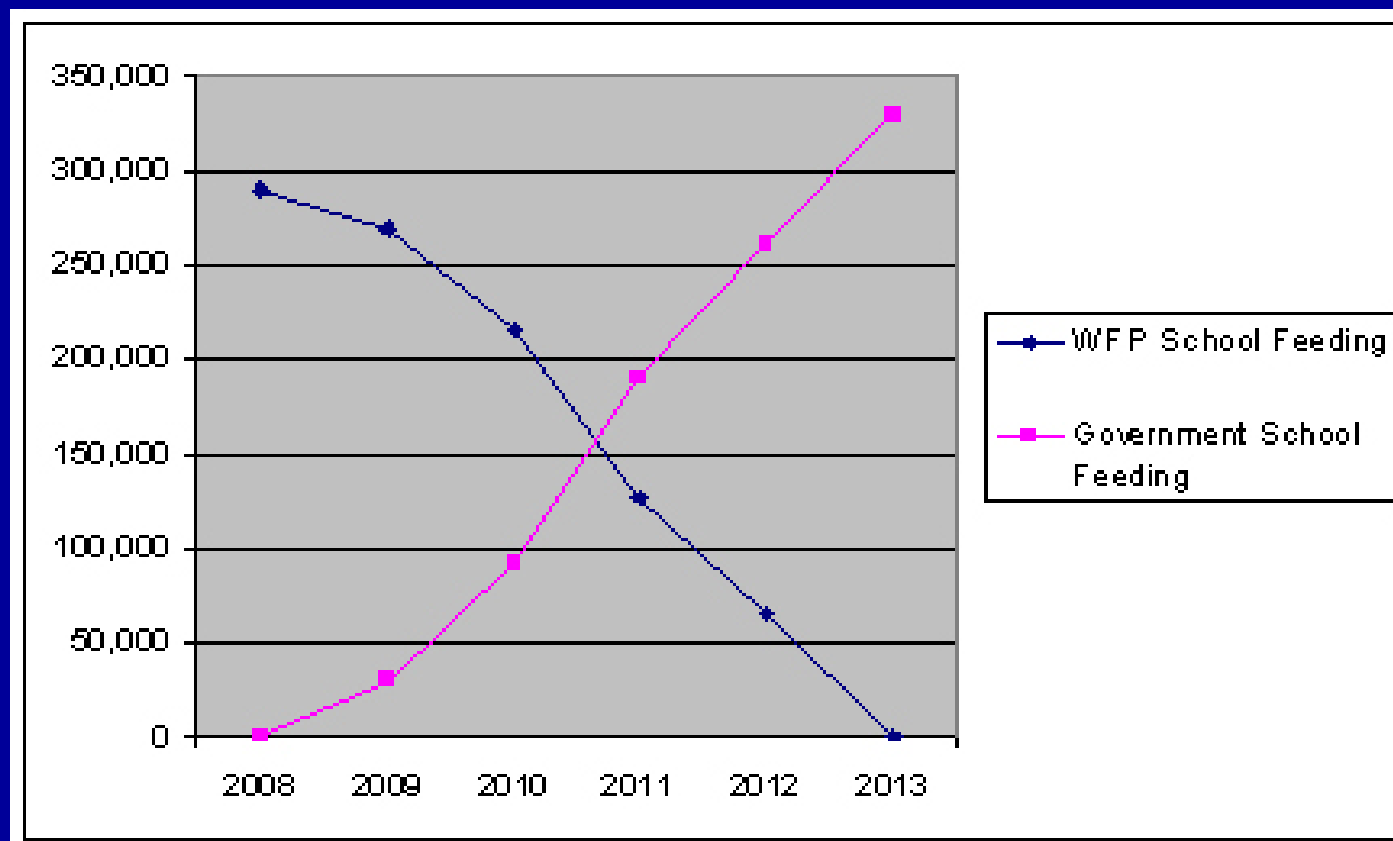
# Objectives
