

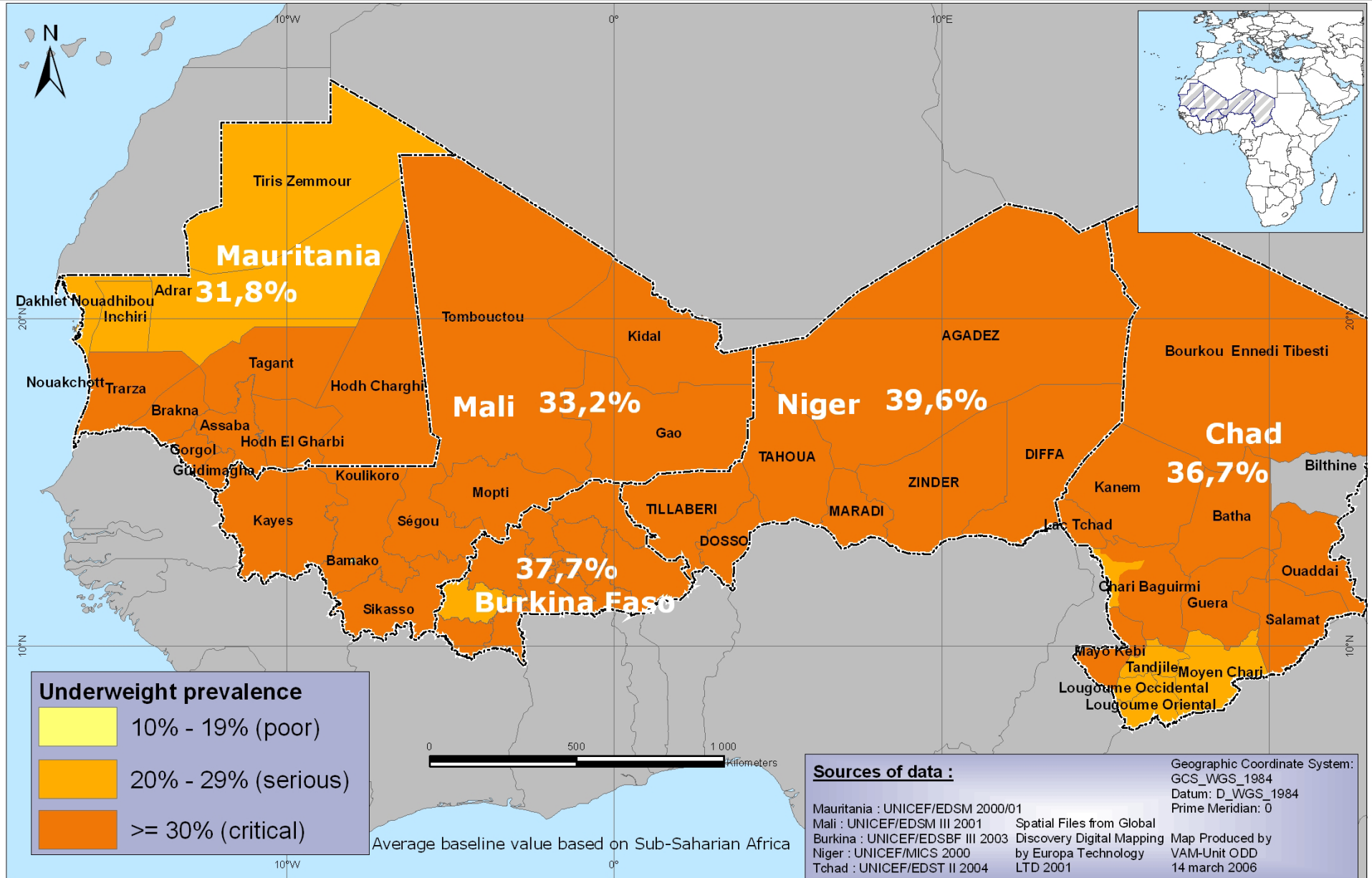


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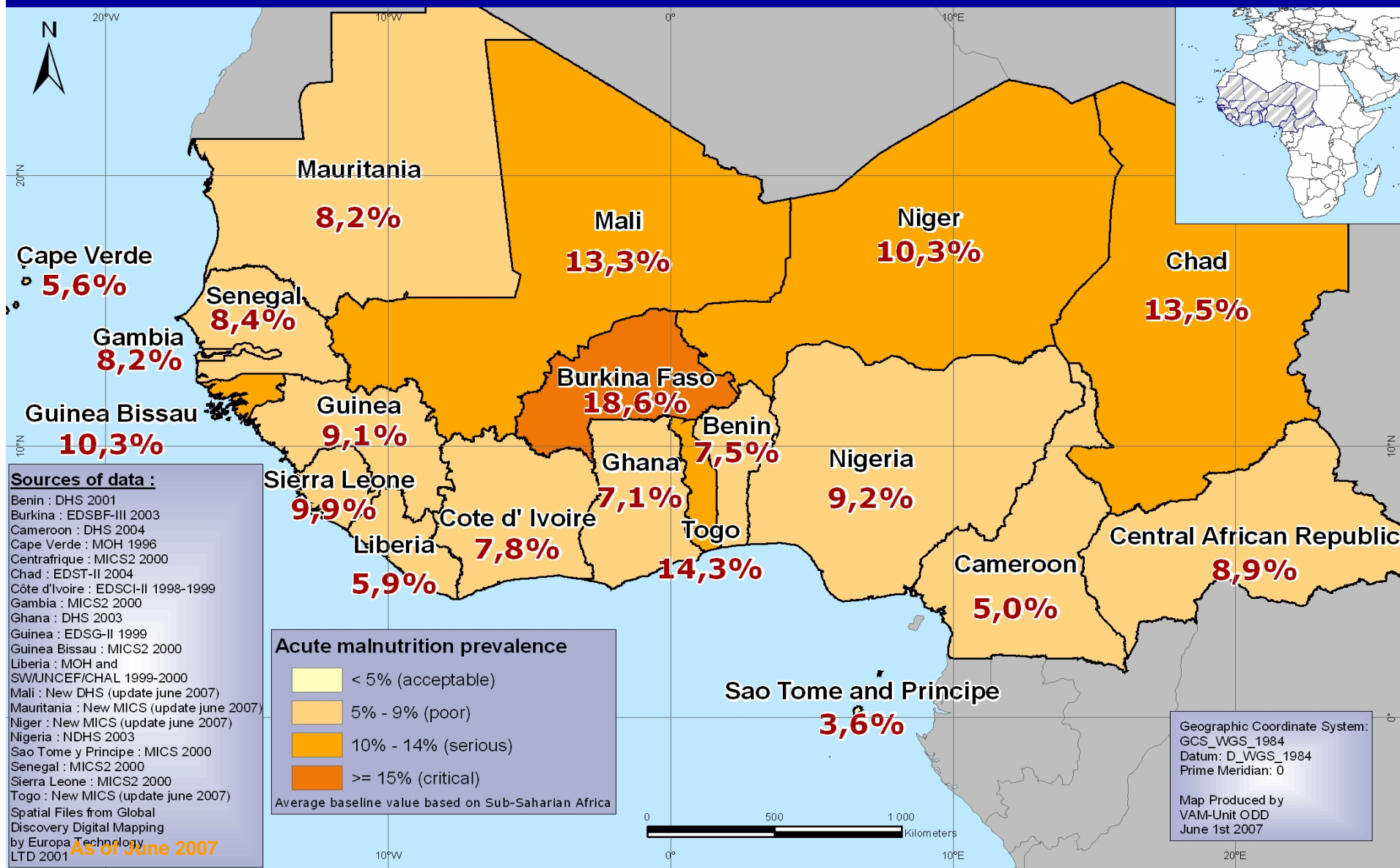

Sahel: A region with some of the highest child undernutrition rates in the world

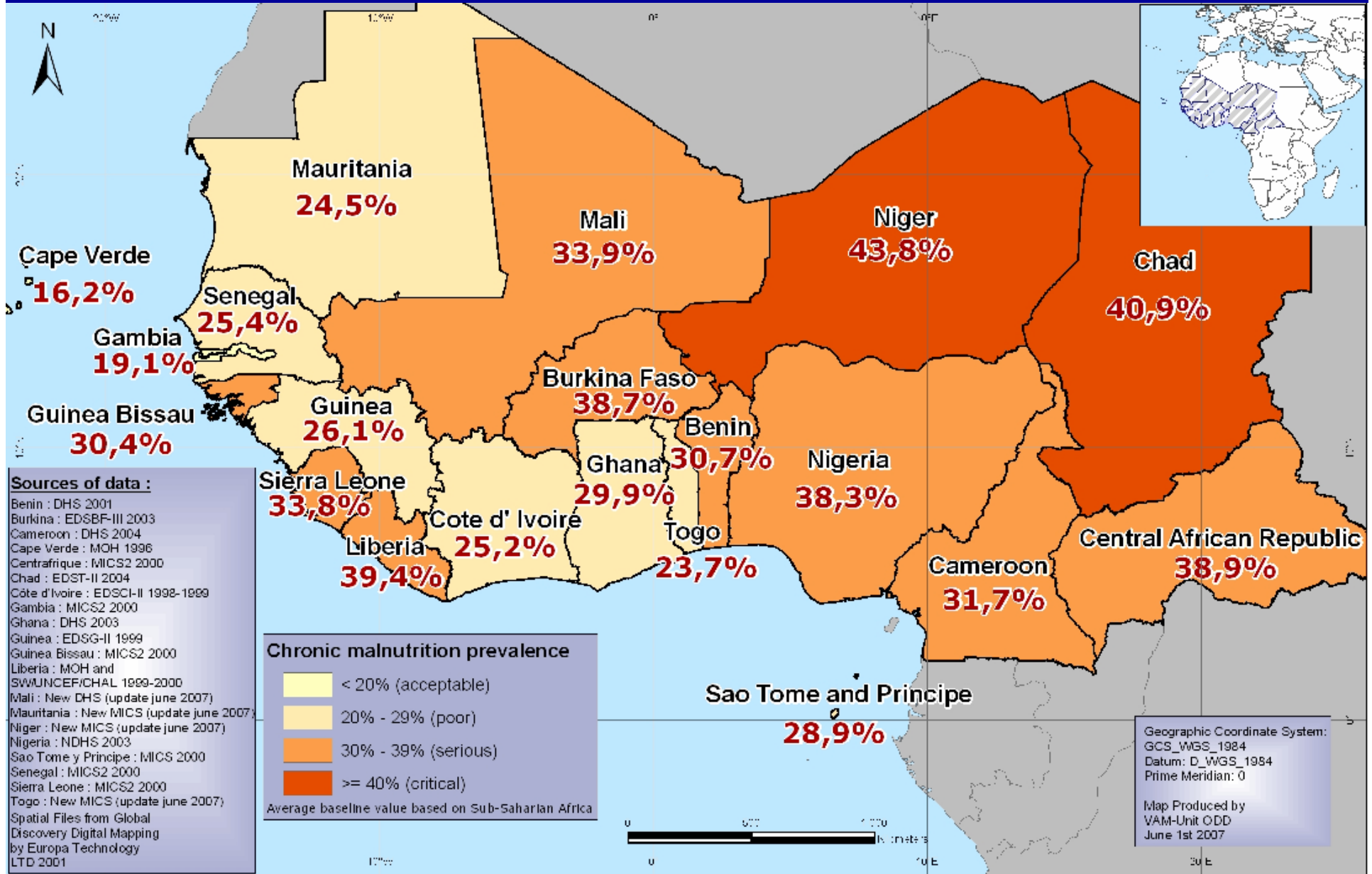


Sahel: Acute undernutrition rates in children among the highest in the world

Sahel Nutrition and Food Security for Child Survival

- **Ownership** – Support national nutrition policies and plans for action.
- **Prioritization** - Prioritize the fight against malnutrition.
- **Scale** - National-scale, high-impact interventions for prevention and care

Mano River Union States

- **In July 2007, Liberia, Guinea, and Sierra Leone will begin the implementation of country-specific PRROs**
- **Projects will support the recovery and reintegration of beneficiaries in Liberia and the rehabilitation of areas and communities impacted by the presence of refugee camps and/or returning populations in Sierra Leone and Guinea**
- **Regional Air Operation facing critical shortfall of US\$ 1.5 million at a crucial time.**

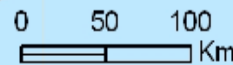

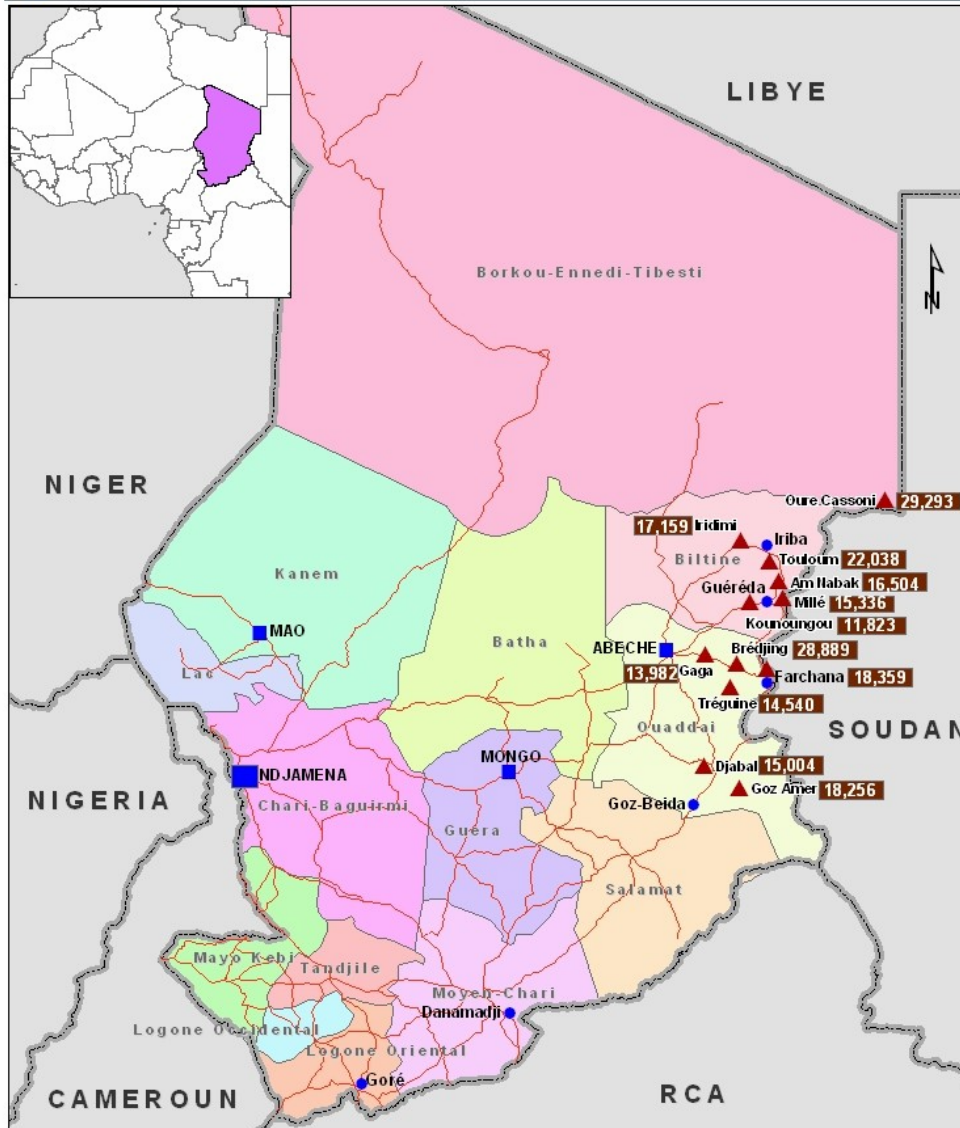
Côte d'Ivoire PRRO 10672.0

- The March 2007 Ouagadougou Agreement has been followed by the forming of a new unity government, the dismantling of the Zone of Confidence, and the redeployment of UNOCI peacekeepers along the “green line”
- A new single-country transition PRRO is planned from July 2007 to December 2008
- Resource Requirements:

- Regional PRRO Côte d'Ivoire + 3 (10372.0) has an outstanding IRA repayment of US\$ 6.7 million

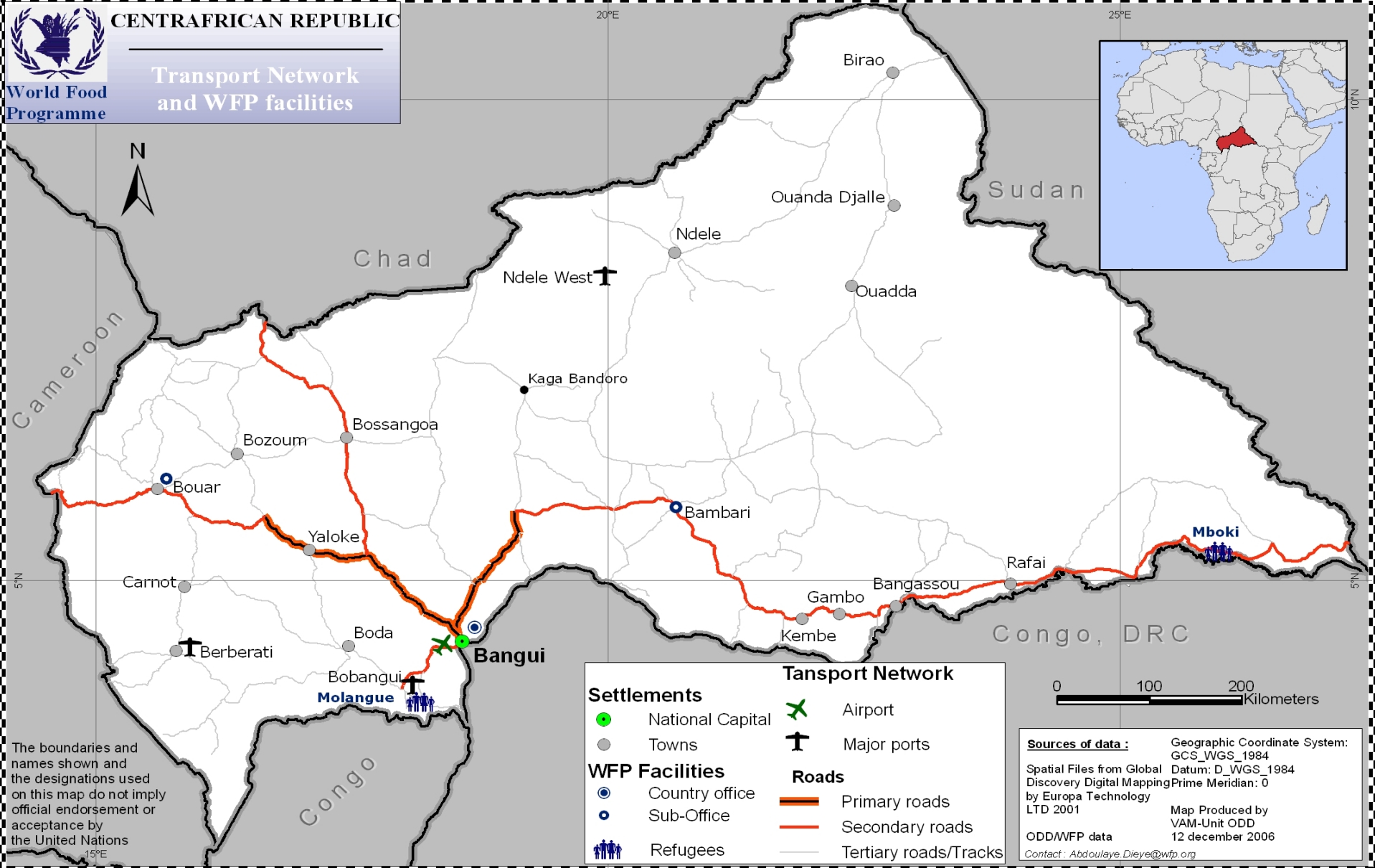

Chad

- **The security situation in Chad is calm, but remains tense and of concern in the East; rebel activity and inter-ethnic violence continue to cause population displacement**
- **WFP is assisting over 500,000 people**
 - Refugees from Sudan
 - Refugees from CAR
 - Affected local populations
 - Vulnerable groups under the Country Programme
- **Pre-positioning of stocks is ongoing to ensure continuity of food supplies through the rainy season**

Central African Republic (CAR)



Central African Republic (CAR)

- **Regional instability in Sudan and Chad contribute to insecurity in CAR**
- **Insecurity has led to the internal displacement of 212,000 people, especially in the north**
- **In response to the increasing numbers of IDPs, a budget revision of the ongoing PRRO was completed for 25,382 mt**

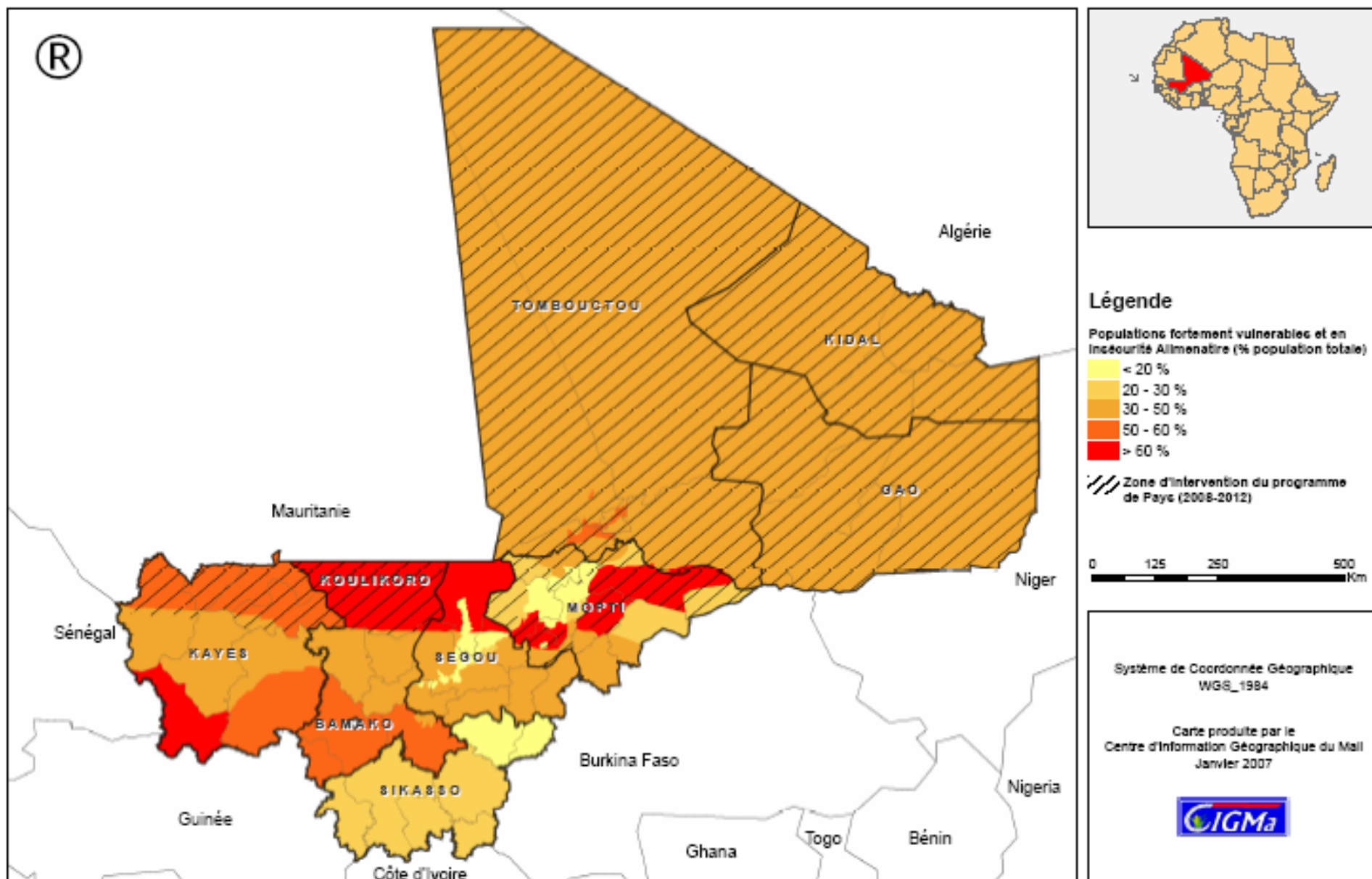

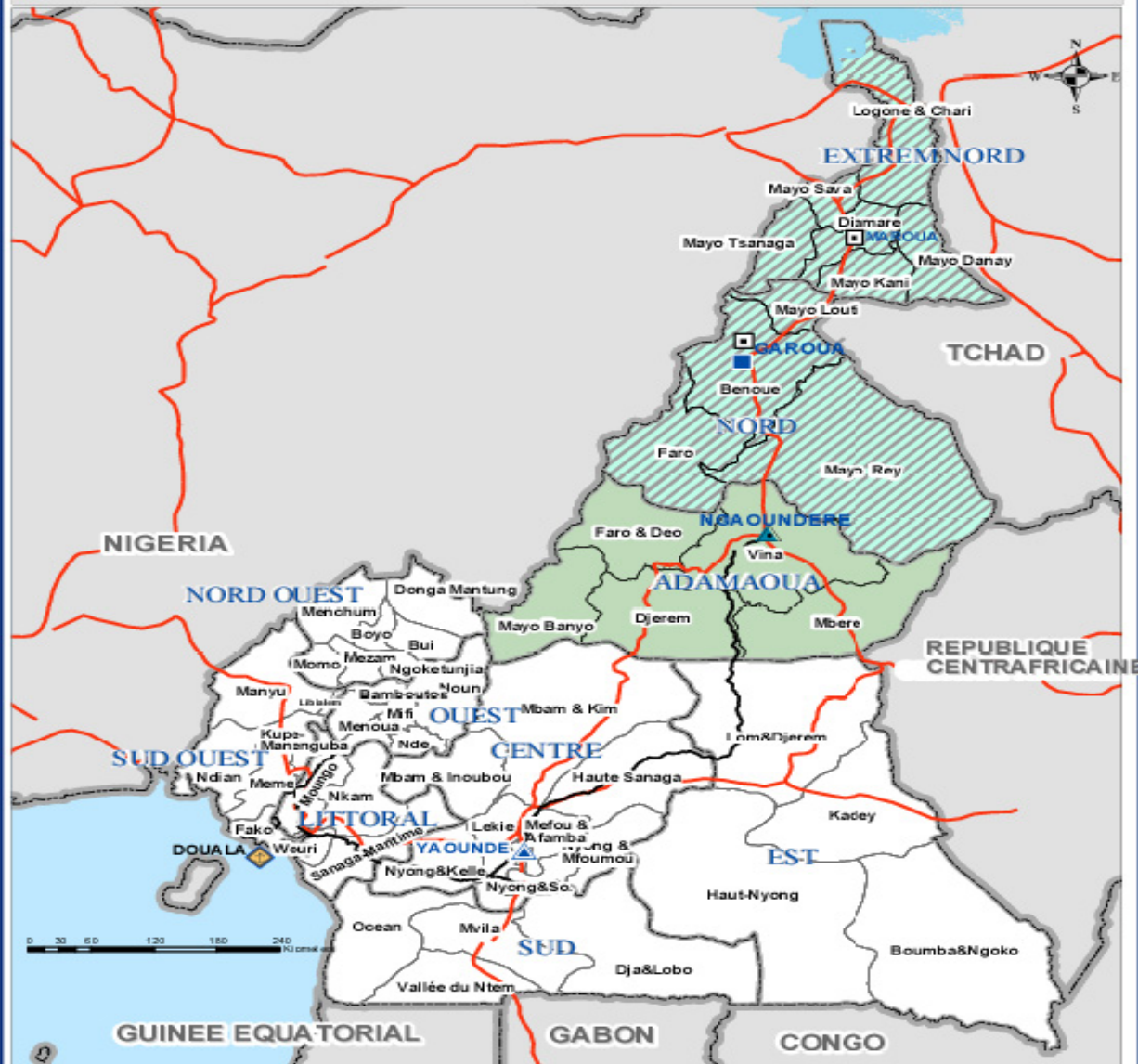
