Yemen - Successes

- Since August 2017, WFP has reached 7 million people a month with General Food Assistance.
- Despite the intensified fighting in December 2017, WFP succeeded in distributing food to all targeted areas of the country and reached 90 percent of its beneficiary caseload.
- WFP is mobilizing 5 million litres of fuel/month for the entire humanitarian community in Yemen.



Yemen - Challenges

- Frequent impediments for implementing assessments, delivering food commodities and monitoring programmes
- Lack of sufficient funding obliging WFP to provide reduced rations to over 50 percent of the targeted beneficiaries
- Evolving security situation's impact on staff presence



Yemen - Risks

- Changing political landscape could lead to large-scale displacement
- Potential for another blockade on Yemen's Red Sea ports
- Increased levels of food insecurity
