

# Timeline for WFP access in Rakhine State

- No distributions allowed in northern Rakhine with activities limited to monitoring since July.
- No access in northern and central Rakhine following 25 August attacks.

- Access restored in central Rakhine on 12 September.
- Distributions conducted directly by WFP with government provided security escort, trucks and labour due to cessation of services by commercial transporters.

- Access in northern Rakhine restored and distributions resumed on 6 November.
- No formal assessments authorized.
- No international staff allowed to participate in distributions.
- WFP was instructed to distribute food in plain unbranded packaging.

- Distributions gradually handed over to some NGOs regaining access in northern and central Rakhine.
- Profiling exercise authorized in northern Rakhine but not completed due to the short time period.
- Delayed distributions in February due to late travel approval.

- Commercial transporters resumed services, and government-provided trucks no longer used.
- WFP given a blanket three-month travel approval for distributions.
- FAO-WFP Crop and Food Security Assessment Mission (CFSAM) conducted.
- International staff given travel approval.
- Country Director visited Maungdaw.
- Regular monitoring and assessment still not allowed.
