## Corporate Approach to Access Vision:

WFP is able to safely access populations in need and beneficiaries are able to safely access assistance

### Systems:

*Ensure understanding of IHL, policy frameworks and UNSCR 2417 in countries in conflict and assess where work needs to be done on internal WFP policy, guidance and commitments; streamline processes for addressing access dilemmas*

- Provision of clear guidance from senior management on recurrent and one-time challenges
- Work across the organization to incorporate SCR 2417 into access strategies

### Leadership and Expertise:

*Provide in-house training and mentorship; improve humanitarian diplomacy and access management skills; support country office leadership in taking principled risks and activating all levels of leadership in doing so*

- Mentoring junior access practitioners
- Supporting country office leadership to develop and manage engagement strategies with authorities and within the UN system

### Operations:

*Capture and share operationally-relevant learning; deployable access support and full-time access staff in-country; Develop planning, analysis and real-time information exchange for access strategies and plans*

- Knowledge management to improve operational access
- More frequent peer exchanges within WFP
- On call expertise
- Analysis-driven engagement strategies

### Partnerships:

*Work with external and cooperating partners to improve context analysis; partnerships focused on strategic engagement and training; more real-time engagement with UN and other humanitarian partners on access dilemmas*

- Enhanced capacity to do context analysis
- External, expert-led training, through the Center of Competence in Humanitarian Negotiations (with ICRC, MSF and UNHCR)
