Key Definitions

Local food procurement

Vorld Food Programme

- Not necessarily produced in country
- Does not always equate to smallholder

Syrian date bars produced in Syria is local procurement
Imported commodities procured in Syria is local procurement

Procurement from developing countries

- Procurement done in countries defined as developing according to OECD
- Can be international, regional or local





Key Definitions cont'd.

Pro-smallholder farmer procurement

Deliberate strategy applying different conditions including specific contract modalities

Smallholder farmer

- Not one single global definition
- Usual definition refers to size of productive land, less than 2 hectares









WFP Procurement Trends

Total amount of food procured 2014-2018 (million mt)






WFP Procurement Trends - Local and Smallholder

Opportunities and Obstacles – Local Procurement and Smallholder Farmers

Opportunities

- Strengthened local economies (LP + SHF)
- Reduced lead time (LP + SHF)
- Beneficiary preferences (LP + SHF)
- Provide access to markets (SHF)
- Price compatibility (LP + SHF)
- Enhanced coordination with RBA (SHF)

Obstacles

- Correct quality and quantity on time (LP + SHF)
- Market disruption (LP + SHF)
- Increased workload (SHF)
