

## Private Sector Partnerships



### Aggregation

South-South cooperation public-private partnership in the Republic of the Congo builds value chain for industrialized cassava flour linking smallholder farmers

### Production

Partnership with Zambia breweries supports smallholder production and market access



### Transformation

Tanzania partnership with Sanku is helping to build capacity among millers to fortify flour



### Consumption

Support the implementation of sustainable school meals that include food quality, safety and training



### Distribution

WFP working with 30 manufacturers on processed foods to improve commodities and supply chains






# Emergencies

## DRC

DRC now has **more people living in crisis & emergency** than any other country

Estimated **21.8 million highly food insecure people**


## Madagascar

Experiencing the **worst drought in five years** & estimated **one million people** require urgent assistance

Global acute **malnutrition rate over 10%** & **75% of children** have dropped out of school in grand south


