

# **Update on WFP engagement in the United Nations Food Systems Summit**

### WFP support to Action Track Five (AT5) and beyond

#### WFP as Anchor Agency (AT5)

- Support to the Chairs and Secretariat of AT5 with embedded experts;
- Helped lay the foundations of AT5 including: Resilience Definition; Discussion
  Starter; content development; and partner mobilization for AT5 discussions;
- Supported each of the initial 5 Working Groups with dedicated expertise;
- Provided WFP-led and WFP-supported Solutions and Propositions;
- Vetting and consolidation solutions, and development of Action Areas;
- Coalition building (mobilizing WFP partners and networks) plus making outreach to different stakeholder groups;
- Preparation for the July pre-Summit.



## Support to other ATs, Levers of Change, and National Dialogues

- AT1 to AT4: Embedded experts, WFP-led and supported solutions, content development, etc.
- Levers of Change: actively engage WFP focal points for Gender,
  Innovation, Finance and Human Rights.
- Scientific Group: drafting support and inputs for specific papers.
- Country-led Dialogues: Mobilizing WFP partnership networks (e.g., Global Network for Food Crises) for Dialogues.
- Post-Summit: work with Coalitions on various initiatives; continual development and application of the Food Systems lens for assessment & analytical and programme design work; continual engagement on national dialogues and reflecting output in United Nations Sustainable Development Cooperation Framework (UNSDCF) and WFP's next generation Country Strategic Plans (CSPs).

- 95 countries confirmed
- **69** Member States Dialogues Registered, **58** already taken place
- 29 Feedback forms submitted
- 20 RC requests received to access financial resources to support MS Dialogues
- First MS synthesis report expected to be published soon
