

ANNEX VI: THE GENDER AND AGE MARKER

1. The WFP Gender and Age Marker (GaM) is a corporate tool that codes – on a 0 to 4 scale – the extent to which gender and age are integrated into the design (GaM D) and implementation (GaM M) of a WFP country strategic plan. To support application of the GaM, country offices have to access the dedicated online platform (<https://gam.wfp.org/>), and respond to a set of questions, referring to the CSP documents or the CSP activities implementation. Detailed guidance materials are available in the WFP Gender Toolkit ([Gender and Age Marker](#)) and training sessions are offered all year around (for information, please contact: hq.genderhelpdesk@wfp.org).
2. The minimum requirement, at the design stage, is for CSPs (and interim CSPs) to fully integrate gender (GaM code 3), thereby supporting implementation of the corporate commitments articulated in the WFP Strategic Plan (2017–2021) and Gender Policy (2015–2020). Of the 5 I/CSPs submitted to the Executive Board in 2020, 3 were assigned a GaM code 3 and the other 2 (Guatemala and Colombia) a GaM code 4.
3. In 2020, all country offices with an active CSP computed the GaM M codes for each CSP activity level, which are automatically reported in their annual country reports under programme performance.
