GLOBAL CONTEXT

- **344.4 million** people from 79 countries are projected to be **food insecure in 2023** –more than double the number **in 2020**.
- An estimated 43.2 million people across 51 countries are at serious risk of famine while 846,000 residing in 7 countries are expected to experience famine-like conditions.
- Armed conflict, Climate Change and Economic Stress is converging with other factors of fragility, creating a global *polycrisis*.






OECD 2022 MULTIDIMENSIONAL FRAGILITY FRAMEWORK

- The OECD 2022 State of Fragility report shows the precarious state of overlap and convergence. 21 out of 60 fragile contexts were affected by violent conflict.
- Amongst these:
 - 12 were highly exposed to climate change
 - 12 heavily indebted
 - 15 are hunger hotspots
 - 15 face high levels of gender inequality
 - 19 are commodity dependent.
