## **ANNEX II-F: OUTPUT PERFORMANCE<sup>1</sup>**

- 1. This annex presents detailed information on output performance for WFP. It complements narrative data provided in part II by giving specific information on each output indicator.
- 2. The output analysis below is undertaken following the methodology stated in annex II-C for which the following definitions apply:
  - a) No. of measurements: The total number of measurements against an indicator.
  - b) *No. of complete measurements:* The number of measurements against an indicator for which an actual value and a non-zero planned value are reported.
  - c) Reporting rate: The number of complete measurements divided by the number of measurements (the total number of measurements complete and incomplete, against an indicator).
  - d) *No. of countries reporting:* The number of country offices reporting against an indicator for one or several targeted groups, locations, activities and/or modalities.
  - e) Relevant countries: The number of country offices reporting complete measurements against an indicator.
  - f) Country reporting rate: The number of relevant countries divided by the number of countries reporting.
