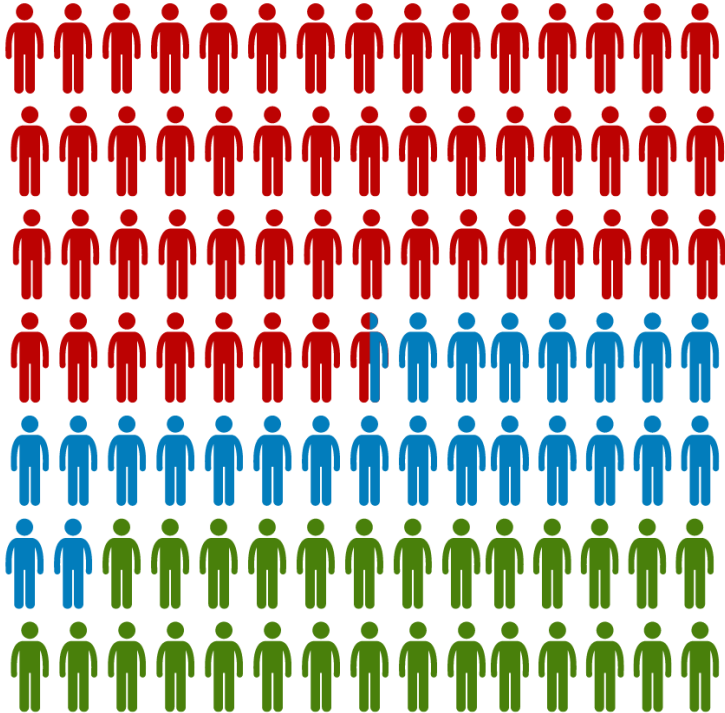
# FOOD INSECURITY AND TRENDS

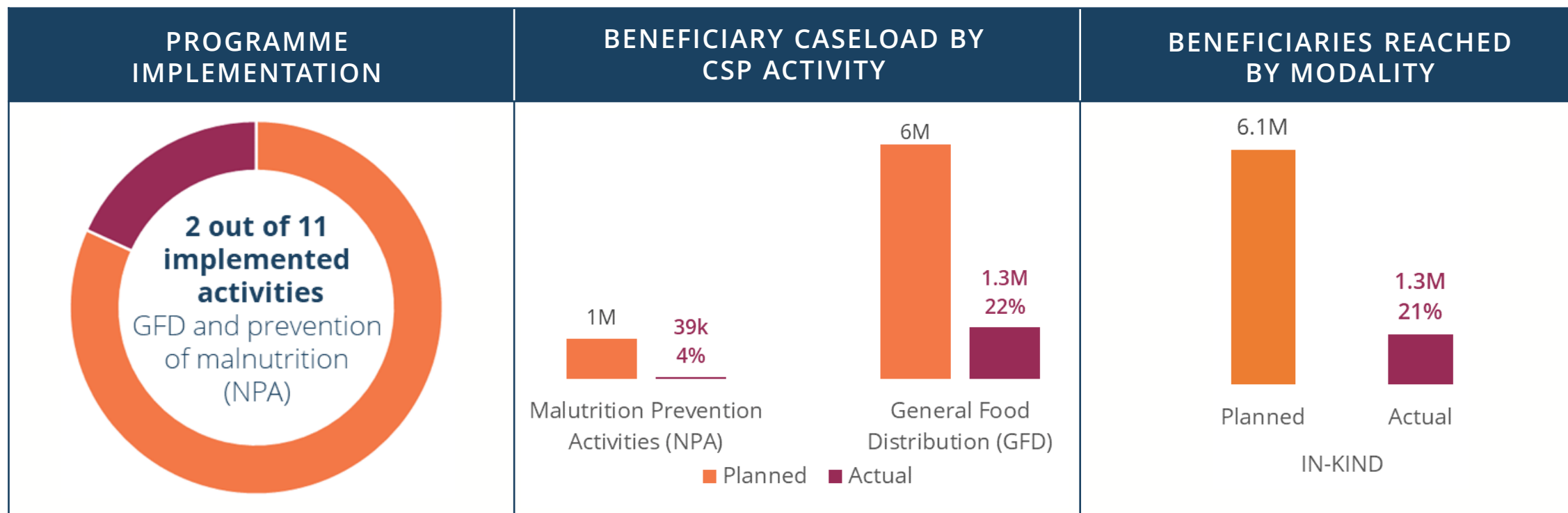

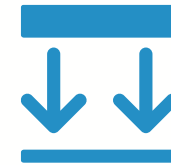
