Annotated provisional agenda

1. Adoption of the agenda

Pursuant to rule III of the rules of procedure of the Executive Board, the Executive Director hereby presents, **for approval**, the provisional agenda for the 2024 first regular session of the Board. During the session the Board may, by a two-thirds majority of the members present and voting, amend the agenda by the deletion, addition or modification of any item.

2. Election of the Bureau and appointment of the Rapporteur

In accordance with rule IV of its rules of procedure, the Executive Board shall elect from among the representatives of its members a President, a Vice-President and three other members (collectively designated as the Bureau), as well as an alternate. Each member and alternate of the Bureau shall be chosen from one of the lists of States as defined in appendix A to the General Regulations of WFP.

Pursuant to rule XII and in keeping with its established methods of work, the Board may appoint a Rapporteur from among the representatives participating in the session.

3. Opening remarks by the Executive Director

Under this item the Executive Director will make an oral presentation to the Board on current and future strategic issues facing WFP.

4. Policy issues

a) Implementation of the Doha Programme of Action for the least developed countries

Further to the letter sent to the President of the Board by the Ambassador of Nepal to the United Nations in New York in his capacity as Chair of the Global Coordination Bureau of the Least Developed Countries (LDCs), and as agreed by the Bureau at its 19 December meeting, the Secretariat will provide an update on how the organization has planned to integrate the Doha Programme of action for LDCs into its activities. This item will be presented **for approval.**

b) Update on the implementation of the aviation policy

Further to the approval of the aviation policy at its 2023 first regular session, the Board requested the Secretariat to present an update on implementation of the policy at its 2024 first regular session. This item will be presented to the Board **for information**.

c) Update on the implementation of the Changing Lives Transformation Fund*

Further to the approval of the Changing Lives Transformation Fund by the Board at its 2022 annual session, the Secretariat will present an update on its implementation. This item will be presented to the Board **for information**.

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5. Evaluation reports

a) Summary evaluation reports on country strategic plans and management responses

The evaluations provide an analysis and assessment of all WFP activities comprising the country strategic plans. They evaluate the performance and results and provide evaluative insights to make evidence-based decisions about positioning WFP, strategic partnerships, programme design, and implementation. The evaluation findings and recommendations will inform the country office's subsequent strategic plan and programme implementation. The Board, by its decision 2002/EB.2/17, recommended that the document on Joint Inspection Unit reports of relevance to the work of WFP submitted annually by the Secretariat to the Board should comprise the following items:

- i) WFP comments on the Joint Inspection Unit reports relevant to the work of WFP received between the submission of the last Board document and 1 October 2023;
- ii) a list of Joint Inspection Unit reports issued since the last reporting period; and
- iii) the status of WFP's implementation of previously approved or accepted recommendations.

In accordance with the practice of the governing bodies of other funds and programmes, the Secretariat presents to the Board each year at its first regular session a summary report containing the items listed above **for its consideration**.

c) Arrangements for the Inspector General and Director of Oversight Office ad interim

The arrangements for the Inspector General and Director of Oversight Office *ad interim* were approved by the Board by vote by correspondence on 15 January 2024. This item will include the relevant background information and will be presented to the Board **for information**.
