



Ongoing bilateral external consultations with select INGOs, local NGOs, UN agencies, donors and member states.


Defining the scope

Priorities and pathways

[1] Local and national cooperating partners are better able lead high-quality responses to food security and nutrition needs and priorities on the ground. [2] Local civil society organizations, including communitybased organizations, are better able to represent local people and address their needs and priorities in relation to food security and nutrition. [3] Local economic actors at the subnational and community levels are better able to contribute to equitable, inclusive and responsive value chains that support food security and nutrition.

[4] Local and national actors are better able to influence and shape food security and nutrition policies, systems and programmes, including the related funding decisions.

#1 Build on, strengthen and share capacities with local and national actors

#2 Adopt participatory approaches while placing local and national actors in leadership positions

#3 Foster collaborative and equitable partnerships facilitated by multi-year funding and innovative financing

#4 Promote mutual accountability and enhance risk sharing
