# Summary of key insights from the evaluation



## Insight 1: Strategic positioning

- **Relevant response to changing needs of the vulnerable**, though further efforts needed re: long-term nutrition challenges
- WFP well positioned to strengthen capacities of **national institutions** – but more focus needed at decentralized levels
- CSP **gradual expansion** complicated the structure – **some programme misalignments**



## Insight 2: Results

- **Successful transfer of school feeding programmes** – an innovative model. Continued investment needed
- Agriculture & food value chain development led to **increased agricultural productivity** for participating farmers
- Support to **social protection systems** is bearing fruits
- Emergency assistance **met urgent food & nutrition needs**
- Notable gains in strengthening **environmental sustainability**



## Insight 3: Challenges

- Small scale of **agriculture & economic transformation activities limited sustainability**
- Room to improve **inclusion of women & PLWD in economic development** and monitoring differential effects on these groups
- Limitations in **staffing constrained effective support**
- **Monitoring systems do not effectively measure** the results of country capacity strengthening

# Recommendations

1

Develop clearer & interconnected CSP structure and monitoring system with adequate staffing capacities

2

Focus on capacity strengthening support at subnational level for smooth handover

3

Strengthen mainstreaming of crosscutting priorities with tailored actions and increase investments in social and behavior change

4

Develop a humanitarian-development nexus approach and integrate with government systems

5

Strengthen and build strategic and operational partnerships to leverage complementarities
