Rec 1. Maintain an ongoing strategic presence in areas of comparative advantage

Key actions

- ✓ The CSP reflects priority areas of social protection, emergency preparedness & climate resilience with a clear justification & results framework.
- ✓ WFP is working to develop a comprehensive Livelihoods & Resilience Strategy.

Rec 2. Focus CCS on approaches that can be integrated into national systems

Key actions

- ✓ The CSP reflects thematic areas in which WFP is best positioned to support the Government's social protection reform agenda.
- ✓ WFP is strengthening climate information systems & anticipatory action planning to increase community resilience & enhance food systems.

- ✓ The CO is strengthening partnerships with the Government, private sector, other UN Agencies and academia to build national capacity & community ownership, for sustainable interventions.


Rec 6. Embed a transformative and disability inclusive approach into all interventions
