Strategic Plan

“WFP reaffirms its commitment to disability inclusion. WFP will invest in meaningful engagement with local organizations of persons with disabilities and will improve accessibility for all programmes. WFP will also invest in capacity-sharing initiatives, remove barriers to food assistance and create pathways for co-designing solutions. WFP will leverage data to improve targeting and accessible programme delivery.”

CRF indicators:

- # of women, men, boys and girls with disabilities accessing assistance and services
- Consulting organizations of persons with disabilities (UNDIS standards)
- Accessibility (Management Results)
- Protection and AAP indicators on safety, dignity and access

2025 Key Achievements

- **75%+** of 2025 workplan delivered despite major constraints
- Support reached **43 country offices** across all regions
- OPD partnerships expanded in **36+ countries**
- **Global Disability Summit** commitments turned into action through pilots and partnerships
- Inclusion advanced in key areas like **digital finance** and **early warning**
- Knowledge sharing scaled up through a global repository and 200-member **Community of Practice on Programming**
